Clergy can exclude a portion of their income designated by their church or salary paying unit as a "Housing Allowance/Housing Exclusion" under Section 107 of the Internal Revenue Code. To be excludible, amounts designated as a housing allowance/housing exclusion must be used to provide housing and must not exceed the fair rental market value of the home. The housing allowance/housing exclusion is an exclusion from income, not a deduction. This means it is not reported as part of the gross income for federal income tax purposes but is reported for social security tax and Medicare tax purposes. The cash paid for housing purposes along with the fair rental value of the parsonage (if provided) must be included in as part of the pastor's gross income for self-employment tax.
